In the $9^{\text {th }}$ grade year, students take 8 courses ( 6 year-long courses, 2 semester-long courses). All $9^{\text {th }}$ grade students are enrolled in Collegio, an interdisciplinary course integrating English, Social Studies and Theology. In addition, all students take a full year of math, science (Biology or Honors Biology), world language, and art. All students take a math placement exam and are enrolled in a math course based on the placement data and teacher recommendation. Freshmen take a semester of Health and Exercise and a semester of Foundations of Faith.
