

## Seattle Preparatory School – *Sophomore Year Courses*

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In the 10<sup>th</sup> grade year, students take 9 courses (5 year-long courses, 4 semester-long courses). All 10<sup>th</sup> grade students are enrolled in Collegio, an interdisciplinary course integrating English, Social Studies and Theology. Students take a full year of math, science (Chemistry, Accelerated Chemistry, or Honors Chemistry), and world language. Sophomores take a semester each of Health, Theology, Arts, and Health and Exercise Science.

<b>English</b>	Collegio – English Composition /Literature	1.0 credit
<b>Social Studies</b>	Collegio – World Civilizations	1.0 credit
<b>Mathematics</b>	Students continue along with the next appropriate course in the math sequence ( <a href="#">click here</a> ).	1.0 credit
<b>Science</b>	Students typically take one of the following: Chemistry Accelerated Chemistry Honors Chemistry	1.0 credit
<b>Theology</b>	Sophomore Theology Collegio – Scripture / Morality II	1.0 credit (0.5 credit per course)
<b>The Arts</b>	Students choose from a variety of Arts options including visual arts, music, and drama courses.	0.5 credit
<b>Health / Exercise Science</b>	Student choose one of the following: Life Fitness I Strength & Conditioning All students take: Health and Wellness	1.0 credit (0.5 credit per course)
<b>World Language</b>	Students continue to next level of World Language*: Spanish German Mandarin *Some may enroll in Level 3.	1.0 credit
