## Seattle Preparatory School - Sophomore Year Courses

In the $10^{\text {th }}$ grade year, students take 9 courses ( 5 year-long courses, 4 semester-long courses). All $10^{\text {th }}$ grade students are enrolled in Collegio, an interdisciplinary course integrating English, Social Studies and Theology. Students take a full year of math, science (Chemistry, Accelerated Chemistry, or Honors Chemistry), and world language. Sophomores take a semester each of Health, THeology, Arts, and Health and Exercise Science.
